During Captain Smith's airline pilot career he achieved multiple type ratings in the following Boeing jetliners: B-737; B-747-400; B-757; B-767-300ER; B-777-200P. He spent a tour of duty in the United Airlines Training Center and was a Line Check Captain for the B-767 fleet. Additionally, Captain Smith was internationally qualified in both Atlantic and Pacific operations. He prides hinself on being one of the most – if not the most- experienced pilot in the the USA.

## **Highlights of Professional Activities:**

Captain Smith was the task force lead for the industry's first Advanced Qualification Program (AQP). He was a member of the ATA/AQP working group and the chairman of its CRM/LOFT integration sub-committee. He also participated in the early design of the crew station for the Airforce/Lockheed F-22 Air Superiority Fighter. Design methodologies were developed by Captain Smith to deal with the effective management of essential mission critical information for the F-22 air combat mission.

**Honors and Awards:** Captain Smith received numerous military awards including a Meritorious Unit Citation for His squadron. Captain Smith received a special Seventh Fleet Citation for achieving the highest readiness and highest carrier landing scores in Carrier Airwing Nine (deployed in the USS Constellation).
